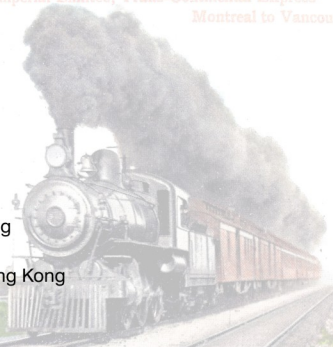


# Gim Suey Chong Timeline

- 1840 — Bein Yiu Chung is born
- 1865 — Hoy Lun Chung is born
- 1869 — Bein Yiu Chung with cousin arrives in America during the Transcontinental Railroad
- 1891 — Bein Yiu Chung with cousin returns to Yung Lew Gong Village
- 1891 — Hoy Lun Chung with brother arrives in America
- 1892 — Moi Chung is born in Yung Lew Gong Village to Hoy Lun Chung and Shee Lee
- 1894 — Cun Chuen Wong is born in Tim Sum Village to Kung Chuck Wong and Shee Lee
- 1910 — Bein Yiu Chung died
- 1911 — Moi Chung marries Kai Leung in Yung Lew Gong Village in Hoyping County
- 1912 — Moi Chung arrives at the Port of San Francisco aboard S.S. Mongolia from Port of Hong Kong

- 1920 — Moi Chung departs from the Port of Vancouver, aboard R.M.S. Empress of Asia to Port of Hong Kong
- 1920 — Marries Cun Chuen Wong in Yung Lew Gong Village in Hoyping County
- 2 — Born in Yung Lew Gong Village
- 3 — Moi Chung arrives at Port of Seattle aboard S.S. President Grant from Port of Hong Kong

- 1 — Departs from Port of Hong Kong aboard R.M.S. Empress of Asia
- 2 — Arrives at the Port of Vancouver, Canada
- 3 — Arrives at the Port of Boston aboard S.S. Yarmouth
- 4 — Attends Webster Elementary School in Cambridge

- 6 — Graduates from Amelia Elementary School in Los Angeles
- 8 — Graduates from Central Junior High School in Los Angeles

Hoy Lun Chung died

- 1940 — Graduates from Belmont High School
- 1 — Enters Curtis Wright Technical Institute of Aeronautics in Glendale
- 2 — Graduates Curtiss Wright Technical Institute of Aeronautics Glendale
- 3 — Enlists as Seaman First Class at United States Naval Reserve. Starts work with Pan American Airways System at Pan Am Treasure Island Base
- 4 — Pan Am Pearl City Base
- 4 — Starts work at Pan Am Mills Field Base

- 1945 — Attends San Francisco Junior College
- 6 — Discharges from United States Naval Reserve
- 7 — Quits Pan American Airways Pacific-Alaska Division
- 8 — Partner at Eddie Pond's Kubla Khan Theatre Restaurant in San Francisco Chinatown

Starts work with Lockheed-California Company in Burbank and Far East Café in Little Tokyo

- 4 — Marries Seen Hoy Tong of Santa Barbara in Los Angeles
- 1955 — Purchases house in Elysian Valley of Los Angeles
- 6 — Raymond Douglas is born
- 7 — Michael George is born

- 1960 — Purchases house at 2251 Glover Place in Elysian Valley in Los Angeles. Builds four-unit apartment building
- 1965 — Purchases house at 2326 Shoredale Avenue in Elysian Valley of Los Angeles
- 6 — Cun Chuen Wong arrives from Hong Kong

- 1970 — Raymond graduates from Irving Junior High School
- 1 — Michael graduates from Irving Junior High School
- 2 — Raymond graduates from Marshall Senior High School
- 3 — Michael graduates from Marshall Senior High School

- 1975 — Moi Chung died
- 6 — Raymond graduates from University of Southern California
- 7 — Cun Chuen Wong died
- 8 — Michael graduates from California Institute of Technology
- 9 — Gim Suey Chong died in Los Angeles
- 9 — Gim Suey Chong is buried in Gardens of Honor at Forest Lawn Cemetery of Glendale
